East and North Acton also boasted station stops on the New Haven Railroad Framingham & Lowell line as the railroad increased in popularity. North Acton's depot, located along Main Street across from Quarry Road, consisted of a station house and freight shed.

A gate tender waits outside the gate house where the tracks crossed Main Street in South Acton, about 1900. Just to the west, the tracks branched to both Fitchburg and Marlborough.
